CALLING FOR PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE ONKAPARINGA RIVER

The Lucentide project is open to all Onkaparinga residents and Onkaparinga river enthusiasts to get involved in, by contributing your photographs of the River, its natural spaces and wildlife.

You can participate in a free photography excursion to take photos, go out on your own trek, or send in photos you have taken previously.

The end result will be a digital moving image assemblage made with photographs contributed by local people interwoven into a spectacular projection. The work will shine a light on the tidal estuary in a low impact creative way.

How to take part and send in your photos

Help illuminart Capture the River Onkaparinga in Light - Bring the river to light by contributing your photographs to a light projection and digital display. You can contribute existing photographs, or take new ones.

The deadline for photo contribution is Midnight on Friday 31 August, 2018.

- Take a camera, take time out and visit the Onkaparinga river.
- Listen, look, do not disturb.
- Take your time, take a photograph that captures the natural spaces and life.
- Take a note of where and when, and your thoughts, wish or feeling there.
- Send us your digital photographs, words and your release form (see last page).

Some tips:

- The river takes in many turns from its source to the river mouth, the choice of location is yours.
- We are looking for a variety of perspectives, from close up shots (such as macro textures of the plants) through to the wider vista.

How to send us your photos:

- Prepare your photos. If possible please ensure they are over 2 Megapixel (2000 x 2000 pixels) - the higher quality the better. Jpeg format is ideal but we can accept most formats.
- Ensure your files are named with your name, or in a zip or folder that labels them as yours.
- Please don't send us watermarked images. If you wish to be credited as a contributor, ensure you give us the full details in the permission form. (found on the last page)
- Make sure you have filled out the permission form and include it with the submitted photos. (scan or photograph it to send it in digitally).

If your photos combined are under 10MB please send them as email attachments to lucentide@illuminart.com.au.

If your photos are over 10MB, please use a web service such as wetransfer.com or dropbox.com to send them to lucentide@illuminart.com.au.

If you have any trouble and need help to transfer them to us please come along to our free info and tech support session, Monday August 27 from 1-4 pm, at the Arts Centre, 22 Gawler St, Port Noarlunga SA 5167 (in the Visual Art Room).

- No experience necessary but it will help to understand some of the technical topics covered.

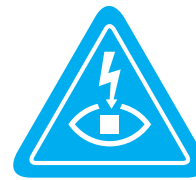


What to bring:
